



BIG launched in October 2016 as a key commitment in the Where Ideas Work corporate plan.




### Why We Exist: The Mission




### Who We Are: The Rigour


#### CASE STUDY: Increasing Tax Compliance

Timely reminders reduced delinquency in PST payments by 50% and saved **2,500+ hours** in compliance-related time over 6 months

### CASE STUDY: Reducing Time to Hire



Reduced hiring time by ~3 weeks for novice hiring managers by providing phone & email prompts at key points in the process


